The "Crickboom" Competition was created and designed for young violinists enrolled in artistic establishments subsidized by the Belgian public authorities (excluding higher education)

This competition is organized by the non-profit organization Artistic Prizes of the City of Verviers.

He wants to allow students to familiarize themselves with the stage and the scrupulous preparation required for a competition.

This competition is intended to be friendly. All of the events take place in good humor and with respect for everyone.

Today, the notion of competition can still be associated with comparing individuals. Our competition aims to be innovative and aims to highlight the experience acquired by each candidate rather than the final ranking.

The guideline is more towards "experience" and not "competition".

Everyone comes out a winner from this adventure: students, teachers, parents and members of the jury. As in all competitions, rewards are awarded but not to the detriment of others.

Everyone will be able to emerge from this experience grown and not with that bitter taste that failure can sometimes cause, among both the youngest and the most experienced.

Values that the "Crickboom" Competition wants to convey loud and clear in the very conventional competition environment.

The view on the quality of services is not diminished. The performances, results and comments of the jury will be approached differently through a diploma for each with signatures and feedback from the jury members.

A constructive way of taking into account the progress to be made in the chosen path of violin, music and art in general. The artistic personality of the candidates will also be highlighted. A desire to put people at the center, with all that this implies for the candidate, by making their project, their background, their desires, their fears, elements in their own right in the way of formulating comments.
